You'll be asked some brief questions about age, income, and other items, such as ZIP Code.

Receive Your Own *Benefits Eligibility* Report.

If you need more help signing up or finding documents, your Benefits Ambassador will help you. Just dial 2-1-1 (24 hours/7 days) and tell them you want to take the *Benefits Eligibility Survey*. They will direct you to a place that will help you.

Also ask about transportation – it's available if needed.

Here's what you'll need to complete the *Benefits Eligibility Survey*:

The survey is designed to identify benefits for a variety of needs including groceries, housing costs, medicine and health care.

You may also choose to answer a shorter survey to just find out about programs that can help you pay for prescriptions, food and utilities.

When you take the survey, be sure to have the following information ready :

- State and ZIP Code
- Month and year of birth for self and spouse; social security number
- Type of home (house, apartment or mobile home)
- Length of time in current residence
- Veteran status for self and spouse
- Names and dosage of prescription medications you are taking
- Current income and assets from all sources for self, spouse and others in your home. (All Benefits Ambassadors are trained to respect privacy.)
- Estimates of current expenses (such as mortgage/rent, utilities, medical bills, etc.)

Having this information handy will help make your confidential Benefits Eligibility screening fast and easy.
